



Katy got an unsteady start in life – but we're not going to let that hold her back.



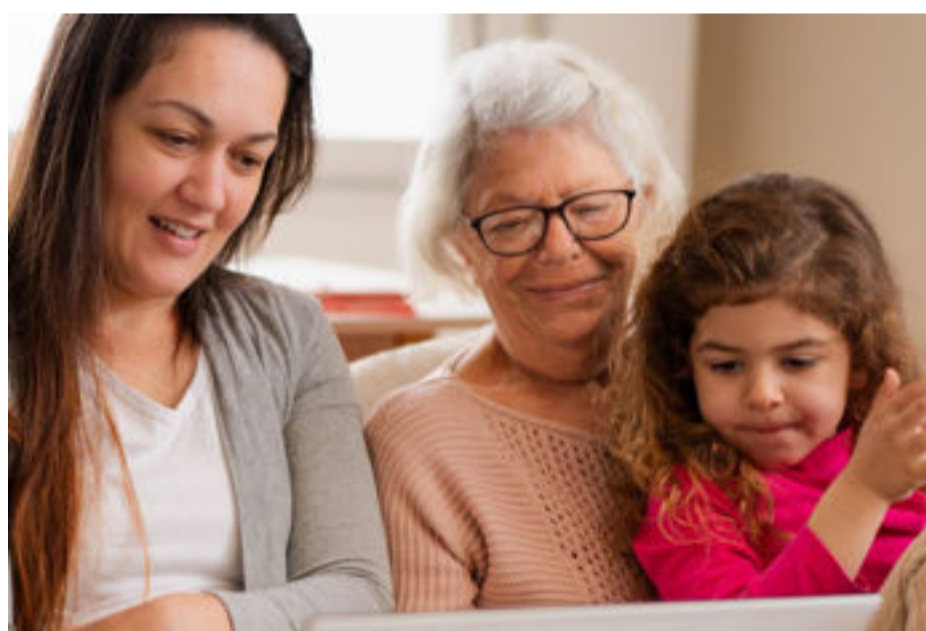
